PURPOSE OF ROLE:

To act as part of GREENWICH Bright Filming and Photography Team. Initially acting as camera operator. GREENWICH Bright are providing filming and mixing services to a number of local organisations and businesses. This role will provide support to this work.

One of the main clients will be Charlton Athletic FC. For this role you will act as a Camera Operator at match days for all Charlton Athletic FC home games. You will be supervised by video / audio technical team and receive the necessary training.

For this role, you will need to have good knowledge of live broadcast mixing and editing. You will normally work as part of a team of students working to a brief from the client.
