- Build on existing international links and develop new partners particularly in North America
- Contribute to the School's successful research culture and inspire others to attain excellence in research and enterprise activity
- Address the School's attainment gaps with a clear plan for action
- Foster an environment for staff and students that is both facilitative and inclusive
