Role Descriptor:

In addition to the generic job descriptors, the Head of the School of Law & Criminology will be an experienced leader who can guide the School through enhancing its existing portfolio of programmes and building on the School's core strengths in employability and industry engagement. The Head of the School of Law & Criminology will be expected to:

- Improve on the School's NSS scores across its programmes
- Develop a plan for the Legal Advice Centre that leads to greater impact and outcomes for students on its programmes
- Develop the summer school model to reach new partners, particularly the North American market
- Ensure that its programmes and portfolio are fit for the challenges of sector changes particularly in relation to developments on the SQE, developing new routes to qualifying
- Foster an environment for staff and students that is both facilitative and inclusive
