

ROLE DESCRIPTOR

Job Title:	Head of School of Stage & Screen

Heads of School work to a consistent job description/person specification and will need to demonstrate our leadership behaviours (see above). This role descriptor has been developed to reflect the local differences across disciplines/faculties.

This role descriptor is non-contractual and provided for guidance. It will be updated and amended from time to time in accordance with the changing needs of the University and the requirements of the job.

Role Descriptor:

In addition to the generic job descriptors, the Head of the School of Stage & Screen will be an experienced leader (from education or industry) who can inaugurate the new School and take it through an intense period of portfolio development and programme enhancement. The new Head of the School will be expected to:

- Build on the strengths of existing programmes and ensure that critical success factors such as student experience are consistently high and more evenly distributed across its portfolio
- Develop a portfolio development plan for the School that is sector-leading, industry-immersive, and partner-embedded
- Nurture the development of an industry advisory board for the School that ensures its programmes deliver an innovative and productive workforce for London's creative industries over the coming decades
- Broker new partnerships, building on our work in North America, in order to ensure internationalisation is 'baked in' to the coherence of all programmes in the school
- Contribute to the School's successful research and enterprise culture and inspire others to attain excellence in these areas
- Address areas where the School has attainment gaps and develop a clear plan for action
- Foster an environment for staff and students that is both facilitative and inclusive
