This role descriptor is non-contractual and provided for guidance. It will be updated and amended fromtime to time in accordance with the changing needs of the University and the requirements of the job.

## **Role Descriptor:**

In the context of Faculty of Liberal Arts & Sciences, in addition to the generic job descriptors, the role will pay particular attention to the following activities:

- To ensure that the Faculty offers best practice and is sector leading in its approach to promoting equity, diversity, inclusivity and a sense of belonging for all staff and all students
- To promote and facilitate interconnectivity across all University of Greenwich campuses and in particular to integrate the work of Bathway into the wider Faculty
- To engage with external partners in order to form new partnership agreements across all the
  disciplines in the Faculty; to build on the work already established, for example, with the RSA
  in order to develop meaningful synergetic partnerships for all programmes in the Faculty
- To develop a cultural strategy for the Faculty and wider university and represent the university at the Greenwich Cultural Forum (and other related forums)
- To oversee and monitor the international partnership work of the Faculty and where necessary to be prepared to travel domestically and overseas to visit partners
- To work with ADs and across Schools and Professional Services to further develop and expand the degree apprenticeship offer
- To lead, together with Schools, the effective governance of PSRBs and work to increase the Faculty's professional accreditations across a wide range of programmes
- To develop the postgraduate taught provision in the Faculty in ways that are informed by shifts in the market and innovations in the future of work
